

# **SALMON UNIVERSITY - OAK BAY - QUEEN CHARLOTTE'S TRIP**

- July 21-24, 2011
- Location: Langara Island - Northernmost Island in the Queen Charlotte Islands, BC
- Description: A 128-foot luxury yacht accommodating 30 guests in double staterooms. Amenities include a comfortable dining room, lounge, and on-deck hot tub
- Communication: Satellite phone (in emergencies only)
- **Rate: Published: \$4,409.76 USD, Salmon University Rate: 35% off or \$2,871.70 USD including taxes and Airport Fees\*\* Rates are based on double occupancy and taxes are 6% HST.**

## **Trips include:**

- Round-trip air from Vancouver, BC – a breathtaking 1 hour, 45 minute flight to Sandspit in the Queen Charlotte Islands, followed by a short 45-minute flight by floatplane.
- Accommodation in double staterooms with private ensuite.
- Excellent meals, including wine with dinner. Snacks, coffee and soft drinks are available at any time, and boxed lunches are prepared for those who can resist returning to the ship for a hot lunch.
- Use of boat, outboard, fuel, tackle and bait from dawn to dusk, weather permitting.
- Professional catch care including cleaning, filleting, flash freezing and vacuum packing. Fish are packaged for airline shipping in plastic bags and airline-approved waxed boxes. Arrangements can be made for canning and smoking.
- Not included: alcoholic beverages (other than wine served with dinner) and BC saltwater fishing licenses, available upon check-in at the South Terminal of the Vancouver Airport.

## **Boats and Equipment:**

- Boats: 17' Custom designed "Fat Cats" with 50hp 4-stroke Yamaha motors, equipped with 2-way VHF radio and Eagle Fisheasy 2 sounder.
- Salmon rods: 10.5' Shimano rods with Penn 320 double action and Shimano 2000 GT single action reels, and 25 lb. Berkely Big Game line.
- Halibut rods: 6' Shimano TLC 66-H halibut rods with Shimano TLD 20 reels.

## **Policies:**

- Reservations will be taken on a first come, first serve basis.
- The block of twenty packages will be held up 60 days prior to arrival or May 21, 2011. At this time, packages without a deposit will be released for general sale. After May 21, 2011, reservations will be taken at the negotiated rate on an availability basis.
- Deposits required: \$600 per person at the time of booking
- Balance of payment due: 60 days prior to arrival
- Cancellation policy: Reservations cancelled more than 60 days prior to arrival are refundable less a \$600 per person cancellation fee. Reservations cancelled within 60 days of arrival are non-refundable.
- Cancellation insurance: \$45 per person (see details below)

## **Cancellation Insurance:**

- Available for purchase at the time of booking and must be paid for with your deposit.
- Cancellation Insurance entitles you to a full refund, less the cost of the insurance, up to the day of departure.
- Coverage: Illness, injury or death of covered person or immediate family member; being subpoenaed as a witness (except law enforcement officers); your place of residence becoming inhabitable because of unforeseen circumstances (fire, flood, tornado etc.); a missed package due to a private passenger automobile or common carrier accident en route to check in at one of Oak Bay Marine Group's resorts.
- Conditions: Our reservations office must be notified immediately upon cancellation becoming necessary, and prior to the start of your trip. Documentation will be required to support your claim (Doctor's note, death certificate, copy of subpoena, proof from insurance company, police report etc.)
